

MILLET STUFFED PEPPERS ON SHALLOT SAUCE

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INGREDIENTS FOR 4 PORTIONS

4 Sweet pepper(s) 180 g each

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FOR THE FILLING	
200 g	Millet
400 ml	Clear vegetable stock
200 g	Onion(s), finely chopped
1 tsp	Olive oil
90 g	Sweet pepper(s), finely diced
	Carrot(s), coarsely grated
100 g	Sugar peas, frozen
125 g	QimiQ Classic, unchilled
	Salt and pepper
	Basil, finely chopped
2	Egg white(s)
	Instant mashed potato flakes
150 ml	Clear vegetable stock
1 tsp	Olive oil, for the baking tin
FOR THE SAUCE	
200 g	Shallot(s), finely chopped
1 tsp	Olive oil
	Flour, to dust
200 ml	Clear vegetable stock
	Salt and pepper
125 g	QimiQ Classic, chilled

METHOD

- 1. Preheat the oven to 220°C (conventional oven)
- 2. Slice the tops off of the peppers and put to one side. Remove the pips.
- 3. For the filling, cook the millet in the stock, loosen with a fork and allow to cool.
- 4. Fry the onion in olive oil. Add the pepper, carrot and peas and continue to cook for a few minutes
- 5. Whisk QimiQ Classic smooth. Add the millet, fried vegetables, salt, pepper and basil and mix
- 6. Whisk the egg white stiff and fold into the millet mixture with the potato
- 7. Fill the peppers with the filling and replace the tops. Place in a greased oven-proof dish. Pour the vegetable stock over the peppers and bake covered for 30-45 minutes.
- 8. For the sauce, fry the shallots in olive oil until soft. Dust with flour, douse with the stock and bring to the boil.
- 9. Blend and finish with the cold QimiQ Classic.
