### **INGREDIENTS FOR 2900 G**

| 450 g      | QimiQ Whip, chilled              |
|------------|----------------------------------|
| 10 g       | Ice cream stabilizer Cremodan 30 |
| 100 g      | Dextrose                         |
| 1 litre(s) | Milk 3.5 % fat                   |
| 350        | Sugar                            |
| 2 g        | Salt                             |
| 1 kg       | Ravifruit blueberry puree        |

#### **METHOD**

- Mix the Cremodan and the dextrose and set aside
- 2. Place all the other ingredients except the blueberry puree into a pot or the pasteurizer and heat to 120  $^{\circ}\text{F}$
- 3. Add the stabilizer/dextrose mixture and continue to heat to 165°F
- 4. Place the mixture on ice or in the blast chiller to cool quickly. Add the blueberry fruit puree.
- 5. Allow the mixture to mature in the refrigerator for a minimum of 2 hours, preferably over night.
- 6. Run in the batch freezer until set, and place into the freezer until hard.
